This year, in your School we vaccinated 35 Children out of a possible 47. The percentage uptake was 74.47% for your School, with the total number of Refusals being 10. However, 2 Consent Forms were not returned by parents. The overall average uptake for Chorley was 56.65%, with the average uptake for Lancashire as a whole being 46.96%. Next year they plan to implement the Flu Programme in 2017/18 to Year 4 Pupils in addition to Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 Pupils.
