Comments made:

Less sugary cakes and biscuits at lunch time More advanced warning of events such as disco on newsletter I feel there could be more on how to join the clubs

Actions taken:

1) Promoted healthy food choices with teachers and children and ensured that the school lunches offer 2 type of fruit pots daily and fruit yoghurts as a choice. Ordering of lunches

- has also ensured that we can track choices and approach parents where good choices not being made
- 2) Use of parent forum, open door policy and revised newsletter and texts means we are communicating with parents more and more timely way. Dates for diary every half term sent and new calendar added to website which will be up and running soon.
- 3) Use of targets in Class 1 is effective and we will be rolling out more target information for all other classes also Spring parents evening and summer term.
- 4) Information pack for new parents for 2017 2018 will include possible clubs and how and when they will receive updates
