Tommy used to attend Bretherton when he was young, lives in the village and has been a huge part of school over his life. We would like to host a celebration day for our children and Tommy on Monday 6th November, our first day back after the October Half term. As he was born on Bonfire night, his middle name is Guy and here are some other facts about 1937, the year he was born:

- Snow white and the Seven Dwarfs Disney film was released,
- The Hobbit was first published
- Amelia Earhart attempt to become the first woman to fly around the world
- Coronation of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth takes place at Westminster Abbey, London.
- The 999 emergency telephone number is introduced
- The first issue of children's comic The Dandy, including the character Desperate Dan, is published.

As you may be aware, Tommy's passion is also Cricket so we would like to ask that children come in fancy dress in anything related to the year 1937 or cricket and we will have a celebration lunch together.
