INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to our first full week and what a hot one it has been. Our reception children have had their induction and are now in full time. Thank you to the PTFA for welcoming our new and existing reception families on their child's first day. All children have settled and are learning well. New routines, new places and new lessons. We have started our Friday Celebration worship at 2.45 and we hope that you can join us. Certificates will be presented and if your child has been awarded one, you will get a text to share in the moment with them. If their birthday has been in the week, they can bring a birthday card in while we celebrate their special day.

We have started the new term with vigour and have lots to tell you in this packed newsletter.

There have been some Covid cases in local schools and so we are moving forward cautiously. We need your support in keeping your child off if they are unwell and seeking a PCR test if they have the Covid symptoms. We will communicate by text or email if there are any concerns at school and if we have any cases we will instigate part 2 of our risk assessment which contains control measures. Part of this may involve reverting to bubbles, using LFT tests in order to keep classes open or as last resort class closures. Thank you for your support.

Start of day and end of day

If I could remind families that Class 2,3,4 are able to access school at 8.40 to 8.50 each day. If your child arrives earlier, they will be unsupervised which is a concern and we want to keep them safe.

At the end of the day, staff are concerned that parents are collecting at the railings rather than coming into the playground and so children are walking around on their own. This is a concern for our younger children so I would like to ask that all Class 2 parents collect their child from inside the playground so that they can be released directly to their parents care. If we could encourage all parents to come onto the playground, the footpath will be passable and significantly reduce the risk of an accident.

After school clubs

If your child would like to attend any of our after school clubs, please complete the google forms as notified. We are grateful we can offer clubs run by external providers e.g. Tennis, Art, Spanish, Fencing, Jujitsu so far and will add more in the coming weeks. For external clubs contact needs to be made with the provider. If you need any contact details please contact the School Office.

Pupils in Years 3-6 brought home a letter yesterday for Fencing Club that is due to start next Wednesday 15/9. Places are limited therefore remember to complete the form and return to school with payment if your child would like to participate. Copy of letter is attached if required.

National Online Safety Platform

Keeping upto date with technology and keeping our children safe online is a huge national priority after lockdown. At Bretherton we have subscribed to the National Online safety platform which provides information on apps and technology for parents and staff to keep us updated with all the new games children will be playing along side lesson plans for children on how to grab the benefits of online whilst being safe. The HUB

Thank you for supporting our before and after school provision—The HUB. We are delighted to be able to offer you this flexible service. After running it for 2 years as part of school, we are looking to review all of our Hub processes including how to book, communicate and invoicing. Swimming

Class 2 will start swimming for this year on Monday afternoons. This will run until early February and then continue again in the next school year so all Class 2 children get a full year of swimming over the 2 years.

Essential Equipment

I hope all have brought in their trainers for our daily mile but if you have any difficulties, please let me know.

Our wonderful Toddler sessions will commence again on Fridays starting 24th September at 9.30—11.00. This will be run by volunteers and you are most welcome. Additions to Consent Form

- 1. Consent to your child accessing and using Google Classroom features in school and through remote learning needs.
- 2. Consent to work with professionals to promote Health and Wellbeing in school as part of our PHSE curriculum

Safeguarding
