Behaviour in school

This week we have been revisiting our behaviour for learning policy in school with children. Through our Personal Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning, our Christian Values, and modelling through our interactions with each other and our children, we are able to teach good choices, self regulate behaviour, kindness, empathy and compassion and a respect for school, staff, each other and themselves. We have high standards and expectations for behaviour both in and out of class which is evident at sporting events and out of school visits as our children are commended for their excellent behaviour.

Young Carer's support

At Bretherton school, we are aware that children can occasionally be in a 'caring' role within the family, providing ongoing care and emotional support to a member of their family who is ill, registered disabled or whose mental health needs are such that the children are under increased stress than a children their age. Barnardo's have set up a system to support such individuals and families and I have attached the flyer to the newsletter. If you feel your child would benefit from this support in any way, please do not hesitate to contact me at school.

Planning for Unexpected events

In school we plan for unexpected events so that our systems and policies are clear and easy to follow. We hold Fire Alarm practices so that children can exit the building quickly and calmly in the event of a fire and we risk assess activities both within and out of school to ensure we keep children and staff safe. These are practiced regularly, without creating anxiety, to ensure staff and children are confident. This term, we will be practicing collecting inside school if an unexpected event such as a storm or unsupervised animal in the grounds were to happen, so that everyone knows what to do. We have a different process for alerting staff and children and would like to practice this in a calm and purposeful way so that if it did ever happen, we could deal with it safely. The storm scenario will be shared with the children to provide a purpose for the practice and everyone will walk through the process to ensure it is clear to follow. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know, however I can assure you that it will only be for a minute or so once this term in order to inform our future processes.

Looking after our wonderful school

We are incredibly proud of our school, its history and the important position and connection with the village. Maintaining our school can be a challenge and a significant cost in times when school's budgets are being squeezed. We have been fortunate over the last couple of years to secure additional funding for essential developments, such as the Key Stage 2 toilet areas (over £,60000), creation of a reprographic room and more recently for our significant boiler repairs (over £5500). This next year we plan to use Diocesan funding to improve our Key Stage 1 toilets (£11000) and improve further our reception outside area. We couldn't have achieved any of these improvements without support from Bretherton Endowed School's Feoffees (Trustees). They are quiet, dedicated supporters of our school and have generously contributed each of the 10% school contributions towards all these capital funding bids. Quite simply, we would not have been able to complete these plans without their generous donations. A member of the Feoffees attends our Governor Buildings Committee meetings and we regularly welcome them into school. We want to recognise the important role they have played at Bretherton school, past, present and looking to the future, so we have plans this year to resurrect '**Feoffee Day'**. This will be a day of celebration and I will let you know the date and content of the day as soon as it is finalised. Watch this space!

Speaking of school funding as it is the time of year when we set our school budgets for the new financial year, I am certain that you may have heard in the national press of the many petitions by Primary and Secondary Headteachers regarding the reduction of money into school. Schools are facing unprecedented budget cuts and increasing costs and as a small school, creative and innovative financial planning has always been essential, but more so in current climates. We appreciate the work of the PTFA to pay for those areas that our budget cannot stretch to, such as ICT equipment, subsidised coach travel, trips, library books and some classroom resources. We are finding replacing items such as carpets, painting, classroom tables and chairs are being put on the back burner each year, so if you have the facility to use match funding through your employer, know of grants or income streams we could tap into or companies who could support or sponsor aspects of school, we would love to hear from you. In the mean time we will continue to offer a high standard of education with all the enrichment and creativity that you have been used to from our dedicated and hardworking staff. Those priorities will never change.

The HUB—how are we doing?

We are at the end of our second term of 'The HUB' and would love feedback on how we are doing and what, if anything, we can do to improve the experience for your child/ren.
