CLASS 4 VISIT TO STOCKPORT AIR RAID SHELTERS

Wednesday 8th January 2020

Class 4 are studying the topic of Britain at War extensively this year across the curriculum and as a stimulus for much of our work in history and literacy. The children have shown huge interest in learning about war and have shown great empathy towards the plight suffered by many. As a celebration of their fantastic enthusiasm and engagement, we have arranged to visit Stockport Air Raid Shelter and to experience life as an evacuee. The trip will take place on Wednesday 8th January 2020.

The educational purpose and proposed activities of this visit are as follows:

- (a) To explore characters through role play
- (b) To extend knowledge and understanding of the period in history
- (c) To enhance learning through use of artefacts and real life experiences

Details for this visit are as follows:-

- We will be leaving school at 9.00am therefore your child should arrive at school by 8.45am.
- Students to return to school for 3.15pm.
- Students will be travelling by coach provided by Avacoach.
- A packed lunch will be prepared by our kitchen on the day of the trip for those who usually have school dinners. Those who usually bring a packed lunch, this should be in a named disposable plastic bag including a disposable water bottle. No sweets, cans or glass bottles please.
- School uniform should be worn.
- An optional maximum of £2 spending money may be taken.
