<u>Class 2 visit to World Museum and Liverpool Philharmonic Hall</u> Wednesday 15th June 2022

We have arranged for Class 2 to visit the World Museum and Liverpool Philharmonic Hall on Wednesday 15th June 2022. They will be able to:

- (a) Visit the World Museum to see real life rocks and fossils
- (b) To watch the Liverpool Philharmonic create art from music which is something the children did within their Beat Band Boogie topic

The children have already studied the topics that we are going to see. They will be enriched through the process of seeing actual fossils in the world museum and we will utilise this time to recap our learning and embed it.

At the Liverpool Philharmonic, not only do the children get to witness the instruments playing, but they will see how art is created which will support their understanding from the Beat Band Boogie topic. We will utilise what we see in further art lessons and within our sketch books.

We will leave school after registration on the Wednesday morning and return to school between 3.30 and 3.45pm approximately (school office will advise if any delays). Children will need a packed lunch in a named disposable plastic bag, no sweets, cans or glass bottles please.
