# **REMINDERS**

#### **Bretherton's Got Talent**

In July we will start auditions for Bretherton's Got Talent. A lovely celebration of children's talents where our whole school can watch and share in the performances. If children would like to think about what they may like to do as we will be holding the heats at lunchtime, this week and next leading to the final on Wednesday.

#### **Class 3 Brass**

If I could ask that Year 5 bring in their instruments Monday 18th July as they will be collected and cleaned over the holidays. When the children move into Class 4, they can continue brass lessons privately through Red Admiral. However, if you don't wish for them to continue, this term will be their last one for brass lessons.

#### **Children using Mobile Phones**

I would like to remind parents that children are not able to have mobile phones in school. If they need to bring their mobile to school for walking to and from school, they can if essential but they need to hand them into the school office on entering school and can collect it at 3.10 before they go home. It must not be used on school premises. This is to support the safeguarding of children and staff. If I may remind parents that children are not able to wear smart watches for school. These are any watches which can accept phone calls or take photographs. Thank you for your support.

#### **Online safety**

If I could encourage parents to discuss with children the importance of monitoring their use of technology and why it's better not to delete any messages sent or received so that parents can review conversations. Educating children to use the amazing opportunities that devices offer is important so that they know that good, respectful behaviour online is as important as behaviour face to face. School and home are a team supporting children with online safety and we are happy to help through our responsibilities within the Keeping Children Safe in education document.

# What's coming up soon on?

A reminder of some of the events to come that you may wish to add to your diaries.

Move up day: 13th July This is a whole day that your child will have in their new class (or with the new children if remaining in their same class) It is a great day that enables the children and teacher to spend time together, getting to know each other in preparation for next year. It is a great day where pupil voice groups are discussed and children are able to get a taste for the learning to come from September. Year 6 children use the day to plan take over day.

Year 6 Take over Day: Monday 18th July On this day, Year 6 become the teaching staff in school. They plan, deliver, mark and evaluate learning so as to understand the world of work. They are supervised by adults in class but it helps them get an insight and appreciation of how children learn. We also have children in the Head, Deputy Head, Bursar and sometimes even an OFSTED inspector role on the day.

**Year 6 trip to Southport : Tuesday 19th July** The famous Year 6 trip to Southport will take place on 19th July and the children will travel in Holmeswood Primary's mini bus and a staff car. A letter will follow.

**Year 6 leavers lunch: Wednesday 20th July** All children are invited to the special Year 6 leavers lunch on 20th July. Lunches can be ordered on the day at registration.

**End of year disco: Thursday 21st July** This year we would like to offer year 6 the opportunity to say goodbye by inviting them to attend the infant disco at 6.00 –6.45 and then the junior disco from 7.00-8.00. #### **Toast**

# Uniform
