Free School Meals/Pupil Premium

I am writing to families who are currently in receipt of Free school meals, those who have previously been in receipt of free school meals and we are still in receipt of 'Ever 6' funding

Pupil Premium money is paid directly to school to support the teaching, learning and experiences and its spending is closely monitored. In school, this can provide additional staffing ratios, pastoral and learning support and other specialist staff, provision and resources.

I have recently reviewed our approach and eventhough the support for children's teaching, learning and pastoral provision is pivotal for this funding, we feel that school may also be able to offer some additional support to families.

If school receives funding for your child and you feel that it would help your family, we are able to offer:

- Fruit for a snack at break time
- 1 after school sports or activity club after school to be paid for (for example Jujitzu, Guitar, Art, Netball etc) to provide an enrichment opportunity for your child for 1 half term per year
- £50 towards the cost of school uniform/shoes* per academic year in eligible years **
- No charge for food and lodgings for our Year 5 and 6 residential, so parents receive a reduction in cost
- All class and whole school trips will be paid for by school you will just need to complete the consent and contact details form and return to school.
- Review of needs and individual plans created to support educational provision.
- Support in the use of technology at school and if necessary at home
- Subscriptions to educational packages recommended from educational specialists specifically for your child for whole school and individuals according to need.
- Inclusion of active opportunities through local sports clubs.
