Dear Parents,

Thank you to everyone working hard at home on your Education at Home lessons. The teachers are happy to see and hear what you have been doing. ## Further opening

We have opened up school further this week and welcomed back classes of our Reception children and Year 6. Thank you to our parents for adhering to the social distance guidance and the one-way systems that we have in place. It was lovely to see them all and they have settled well to our new routines.

Our Year one children returning are in school on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and will be joined by our younger keyworker children on those days. As with all groups, there will be no more than 15.

### Availability

I have asked keyworker parents over the last 2 weeks to let school know if they need any sessions so that we can arrange provision. These sessions are used where parents are keyworkers and cannot keep their child safe at home. We are now approaching the limit of numbers in those groups based on the staffing and rooms we have available. This is unfortunate, but this is the situation we are in.

Therefore, in summary, we will be unable to accept any further children of keyworkers before the end of term. If you are in a position where a session is needed, please contact me and we will operate a waiting list to monitor numbers.

## School lunches

Any children in school now can access a school packed lunch. For children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 they can have a free universal school meal so will have a packed lunch provided by school. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they too will have a lunch provided. If your child is in Year 3,4,5,6 and in school, they can order on the day a school packed lunch for the cost of £2.30. If your child orders a lunch, the cost will be added to the online parent payment facility.

Thank you to Mrs Williams, Mrs Barratt and Mrs Hudson for preparing an array of great learning. From a reading book to keep, to stationary and books to use, we cannot wait to find out how you get on.
